The tempo of the journey reaches its peak in Gdańsk, which boasts the Baltic's most beautiful beach, Sopot. Extend your stay in Copenhagen to explore the Amalienborg Palace, the queen's winter residence, then visit the Little Mermaid statue, the fairy-tale symbol of the city.

Top-shelf adventures await where Horatio Nelson once dropped anchor. Sip potent Antiguan rums; shop sassy St. John's, trip-out on rose-colored sands of sister island Barbuda; savor the rare Antigua Black Pineapple that grows only on these verdant shores. Hummingbirds, herons, parrots in every color, Puerto Rico's landscape is a vibrant painter's portrait. This journey fully displays Mother Nature's tour de force of beauty above and below the Caribbean Sea's surface. With a lovely enticement of ease, we begin in Barbados, an island of wonders: flying fish, green monkeys, subterranean waterfalls, and towering banyan trees with shaggy aerial roots that inspired the island's Portuguese name, the "bearded ones."


Sail where mountains have no names, roads are few, and vast wildernesses are gateways beyond the imaginable.

Remote Wrangell is a rarely seen gem that is nestled deep

within a maze of 1,100 islands. 





All the senses are arrested in Icy Strait Point at Hoonah, where wildlife outnumbers people. Beyond belief, we gather in awe to watch Hubbard Glacier shoulder its way to Disenchantment Bay.

A site that never disappoints is Valdez. You'll need to pinch yourself to ensure you're not dreaming, especially in Juneau where Mendenhall Glacier and snowy peaks push skywards. Wild adventures continue in Sitka with its Russian history and Fortress of Bears. We turn to follow whale's moving southward and return to British Columbia and explore Victoria and Vancouver.
